







Do you have any other comments?

1. The most important thing that needs to be done is to correct the poor drainage in the park. I believe the drainage problem will be addressed in all of the schemes that have been presented. I question the placement of the portable toilet as shown in Scheme 1. It is shown in an odd place. It is most likely to be used during baseball games when there will be a lot of people, especially children, in that immediate area. It seems like the toilet should be located in a somewhat more private area away from the highest concentration of people.
