The Park District of Oak Park values community participation and input in helping to shape the future of Oak Park parks and facilities. Oak Park residents are invited to attend a community meeting to provide input regarding the current and future use of Euclid Square Park for the development of a site master plan. The overall objective of a site plan is to provide “a blueprint for future park renewal.”

Euclid Square Park is a 2.81 acre park located at 715 W. Fillmore, one block east of Oak Park Avenue and one block north of Roosevelt Road. Current park amenities include an all-purpose field, a 60' baseball/softball field, four tennis courts, and a playground apparatus.
