- Admission to Family or Public Skate is \$6/person or by season pass.

- During Family Skate anyone under the age of 18 must be accompanied by an adult guardian.
- Admission to Adult Skate is \$4/per person or by season pass. Participants must be 18 years old.

Paul Hruby Ice Arena at Ridgeland Common

The Paul Hruby Ice Arena at Ridgeland Common provides Learn to Skate, Hockey, and Recreational Public Skating programs to the community. It is a seasonal rink in operation October through March.

for preventative maintenance and cleaning, and to prepare for the upcoming skating season. Scheduled programs will run, but onsite registration will NOT be available. You may still register for programs online or at our Administrative Center, 218 Madison in Oak Park.

Ridgeland Common Indoor Playground

Children ages 8 months to 5 years will enjoy interacting and playing with other children in the indoor playground located upstairs at Ridgeland Common. No shoes or food permitted in the playground.

Skate Rental and Skate Rental Card

Hockey and figure skates are available to rent for \$2 a pair during all hockey, figure skating, and public skating programs. Pre-purchased rentals are available that allow individuals or families to pre-purchase 10 rentals at a discounted rate. Your name, with the number of rentals you have paid for, will be on file in the skate shop. All pre-purchased rentals are good for the Fall 2009-Winter 2010 season. Reminder: All rentals purchased prior to the Fall 2009-Winter 2010 season that have not been redeemed, have expired.

Ice Skating Passes - Purchase IN PERSON ONLY

Skating passes are available for anyone who attends public or noon skating sessions frequently. Passes purchased this season are valid for the Fall 2009-Winter 2010 season. All passes are in the form of a photo ID that must be taken at Ridgeland Common, M-Sa, 9am-5pm and during all public skating sessions.

Proof of Residency: Oak Park residents wishing to take advantage of the reduced resident rate must provide 2 forms of ID with your Oak Park address when registering. Drivers license, voters registration, utility bill, school ID or a personal check with your address are all acceptable.
