Ice Skating Passes

First Time Buyers Must Purchase In Person

Skating passes are available for anyone who attends public or noon skating sessions frequently. Passes purchased this season are valid for the Fall 2009-Winter 2010 season. All passes are in the form of a photo ID that must be taken at Ridgeland Common, M-Sa, 9am-5pm and during all public skating sessions.

Proof of Residency: Oak Park residents wishing to take advantage of the reduced resident rate must provide 2 forms of ID with your Oak Park address when registering. Drivers license, voters registration, utility bill, school ID or a personal check with your address are all acceptable.

Looking for Polar Bear Passes?

Each spring, the Park District of Oak Park offers an advance sale on the coming pool season and next year's rink season with great savings for our residents. We call this our "Polar Bear Pass Sale." The 2010 Polar Bear Pass Sale will begin March 2 and run through May 9. Pool passes will be valid for the summer of 2010 and rink passes for 2010-2011. Polar Bear Passes can be purchased just for the pool season, or for the combined pool and rink season. The pool passes are good at both outdoor pools, Rehm Park Pool and Ridgeland Common Pool, for all family and public swimming sessions - providing unlimited visits to the pool! Activities On The Ice

Public Skating Information

- Admission to Family or Public Skate is \$6/person or by season pass.
- Hockey and figure skates are available to rent for \$2 a pair during all hockey, figure skating, and public skating programs. See Skate Rental below.
- During Family Skate anyone under the age of 18 must be accompanied by an adult guardian.
- Admission to Adult Skate is \$4/per person or by season pass. Participants must be 18 years old.
- Friday Evening Public Skate will not be held when FRIDAY NIGHT ICE is scheduled. See page 15 for dates.

All About Skate Rentals

Hockey and figure skates are available to rent for \$2 a pair during all hockey, figure skating, and public skating programs. Pre-purchased rentals are available that allow individuals or families to pre-purchase 10 rentals at a discounted rate. Your name, with the number of rentals you have paid for, will be on file in the skate shop. All pre-purchased rentals are good for the Fall 2009-Winter 2010 season. Reminder: All rentals purchased prior to the Fall 2009-Winter 2010 season that have not been redeemed, have expired. Skate Rental Card Fee: \$17 for 10 rentals
